# An insight into our Summer School Program

# K3 - Ms.Teresa Velez (Homeroom) Ms.Faye Balugo (Assistant Teacher)

Children will be engaged with a variety of activities that support the school curriculum in a more relaxed learning environment. Children will unleash their creative sides with arts and crafts, music and movement and cooking experiments. Water play activities will be an essential part of the program especially when the summer temperature starts soaring high. Children will also learn essential skills needed to prepare them for a smooth transition to the next grade level.

#### K4/5 - Ms. Makiko Kuroda and Ms. Madoka Shinshi (Homeroom Teachers)

We will be enriching our language skills through nursery rhymes, games, action songs, (music and movement) and story play. Students will continue to develop strong conceptual understandings in maths through maths learning stations. A unit of inquiry will be introduced in the first week. Opportunities to link language and numeracy skills to our inquiry will ensure authentic learning. Students will also enjoy water play activities throughout the duration of summer school.

#### Grade 1 -Ms. Stephanie del Rosario (Homeroom) Ms.Harsha Daryanani (Teacher Support)

We will be exploring a number of key and related concepts that are connected to our central idea. We will focus on improving specific literacy and maths skills that are applicable to the unit. Students will also have opportunities to learn other skills through subjects such as art and swimming.

# Grade 2 - Ms. Kathleen de Silva (Homeroom) Ms.Harsha Daryanani (Teacher Support)

Throughout the duration of our summer school, we will be focusing on improving not only our language and maths skills but will also be developing our organization and time management skills. Through the transdisciplinary theme 'Sharing the Planet' we will be inquiring into the importance of plants to all living things. Authentic connections in maths, language, art and science to our unit of inquiry will further enrich our learning.

#### **Grade 3 - Mr. Duncan Harris**

During summer school, students will continue to develop language and numeracy skills through a variety of meaningful learning experiences. Our central idea, 'Traditional stories help us make sense of our world and understand universal messages in an entertaining and enduring manner' will be introduced in the first week. Authentic connections to all learning areas will be made through our unit of inquiry.

#### **Grade 4/5 Ms.Karen Chen, Ms.Monique Raciti, Mr. Robert Meyer (Homeroom Teachers)**

Throughout the duration of our summer school, we will be focusing on improving language, thinking and problem-solving skills. A unit of inquiry will be introduced in the first week. We will inquire into How We Express Ourselves through different forms of literacy including poems, plays, novels, comics, fantasies and so on. Transdisciplinary connections will be made throughout the unit encompassing areas in literacy, maths, science and art. In maths, we will be looking at pattern and function to promote abstract thinking and generating rules. Amazingly, a lot of the art forms will also require this knowledge. We are planning to make some beautiful wind chimes suitable to be hung on the windows frames in the summertime. Opportunities to apply these skills through our inquiry will ensure authentic learning.

#### Music - Mr. Nobuhito Koike

Through the transdisciplinary theme 'How We Express Ourselves' K3 and K4 students will learn various instruments and creative movements through songs. They will also learn to dramatize the story content in songs. K5 and Grade 1 students will deepen their knowledge of music with focus on writing music notes through the transdisciplinary theme 'How We Organise Ourselves'. Students will apply these skills to create their own song and perform to an audience.

Grade 2 and 3 students will learn to play Orff instruments such as xylophones and marimbas in groups. Students will learn how to care for these instruments and how to work collaboratively.

Grade 4 and 5 students will explore a variety of percussion instruments. They will then apply this knowledge to help them create background music for a story of their choice.

## **MYP** and **DP**

The Secondary classes will develop a program that fits the needs of each student. Courses will focus on Language Arts in the areas of both communicative and academic English, expressing thoughts and opinions in both written and spoken forms. Students will have the opportunity to participate in specialized subjects in maths and other subjects.

# Grades 6/7 - Mr.John Bullock

We will be conducting a writers workshop where we explore the construction of four essay formats both fictional and non-fictional. In addition, there will be classes on Executive Function and Growth Mindset, as well as a "Genius Hour" Education project in the style of A.J. Juliani and other innovative educators.

#### Grades 8/9 - Mr. Hideo Takamizawa

We will be focusing on improving our English language skills in all the four domains, listening, speaking, reading and writing to enable ourselves to function actively and effectively in a more challenging environment. We would also like to improve and enhance lifelong skills such as time-management skills, organization skills, communication skills, and creative thinking skills.

#### Grades 10/11 - Ms.Soulef Batnini

Learners will focus on their Independent Learning Project based on their stated academic goals as directed by their Homeroom Teachers. In addition learners will learn strategies to build their academic skills and maintain time management, and building confidence through communication in English.

# Global Leadership - Mr.Kokoro Ozawa

In the Global Leadership Course, we will be focusing on dealing with deep questions regarding contemporary issues in areas such as human science and natural science. After setting up an exploratory learning goal, we aim to develop these skills to enable us to better consider a wide range of issues in society.

#### Individual and Societies - Mr.Borrys Ferrick

Summer is an excellent opportunity for students to apply their learning and understanding towards developing the lifelong skills they will need to realize their future aspirations. Individuals and Societies encompasses the reality of balancing one's public and private life, as well as setting and achieving goals on personal and collective levels. Students will be challenged with high-interest topics, which relate to their own thoughts and experience in order to gain a more sophisticated worldview.

## **Design - Mr. Borrvs Ferrick**

The Design component will allow students to conceive an idea to make something, research its feasibility, create a well documented action plan, build it, present it, and reflect back on the progress to own the process. Design is the basis of problem solving through a series of carefully calculated steps, which when fully developed, increase the likelihood sustainable success in personal endeavors.

# Physical Education(All grades)- Mr.Sam Alatiit (PE Teacher) Mr.Aram Ibrahimi (Assistant)

Students will participate in swimming activities. Swimming sessions will focus on water safety, skill instruction for freestyle, and organized games such as water polo. Students will also have an opportunity to participate in swimming races at the end of the summer program.
