The K2 children have been experiencing and learning many new things over the past six weeks. They 1) practiced their self-management skills by learning to cope and be away from their parents for an extended period of time, 2) applying research skills to explore their new school environment, 3) eating by themselves, and 4) taking a nap with their friends. They also 5) started building their social skills by playing with friends, showing their way of communicating with other peers and being more confident in new social situations. The children are getting used to the school routines and showing interest in building relationships with their teachers and friends.



















K3 children have settled into Morning Glory class and Sunflower class with Ms. Rachel, Ms. Makiko, Ms. Allison and Ms. Casie. A lot of learning has been happening. This includes:



Taking responsibility in taking care of the classroom turtles: Apple & Heart. Making sure they are clean and fed.







Who We Are Learning about the letters in our names and our likes and dislikes of fruits. Children graphed their results onto a poster. (Maths - Data Handling and Counting Numbers)







Where We Are in Place & Time

Collaborative art in mixing primary colours to form secondary colours. The experience facilitated the children in engaging social skills by sharing, turn-taking, and working together to achieve a goal.

Cooking

Weekly cooking experiences to enhance fine motor skills, reading recipes, understanding measurement, etc.





K4 children have settled into Carrot class and Rabbit class with Ms. Erika, Ms. Merle and Ms. Casie. This is what the K4 children have been learning:







Sharing the Planet Applying research skills to find out about what living things are. Children have shown a strong interest in butterflies and dragonflies. They went for a nature walk and brought a mat and notebook to document what living things they observed.



Learning Stations Structured learning stations to learn more about literacy, numeracy.







K5 children have settled into their class with Mr. Paul and Ms. Sachiko. K5 children have been exploring their year-long inquiry **Sharing the Planet**. This unit's Central Idea is: Responsible actions may contribute to conflict resolution. Here are some of the things they have explored:



K5 children collaborated in teams to come up with their classroom Essential Agreements:

- Share, Be caring to friends,
- Speak English
- Clean up, Listen to
- everyone, Be quiet,
- Say nice things,
- Wash your hands







Exploring the Learner Profiles "Caring" and "Principled" and coming up with examples and actions to go along with them.

WHAT CAN I DO?

Learning about what it means to be responsible and silly. Children also discussed whether problems are big or small. They created the Wheel of Choices to find out how to resolve their problems independently







K5 children have also been using role play to explore different types of conflicts and coming up with solutions to resolve them.

K5 children have also been reading leveled books and learning addition and subtraction.



Specialist Classes Japanese, Art, Music, PE , Library and ICT classe.





K2 children have 1 PE class and 3 Music classes each week with Mr. Nobu. The children enjoy learning and singing new songs and engaging in different gross motor skills exercises.





K2 to K5 children have 2 music classes and 1 PE class with Mr. Nobu each week. Now that Autumn is here, the children will be having PE at the park. K2 to K5 children have 1 library class each week with Ms. Allison. K2 children have been listening to stories relating to their interests. K3 to K5 children have been learning more about the IB
