Developed in cooperation with the International Baccalaureate (IB), the Aoba IB Online DP pilot represents one of the world's first 100% online high school programs designed to support students in studying for and achieving the IB Diploma.

The Aoba IB Online DP prepares students for success. Upon completing the program students will be eligible to study at leading universities around the world, facilitated by Aoba's expert university guidance counsellors and a range of student support services.

The programme is part of Aoba and the IB's strategy to realise a shared vision for making high quality international education more accessible, flexible, inclusive, and convenient in order to support students to pursue their passions and succeed in their endeavours both during and beyond their high school careers.

To that end, the Aoba Online IB DP leverages cutting edge learning technologies and modern education approaches to deliver an experience that is built around how today's high school students communicate, collaborate, and learn in a hyperconnected world.

### **IB Online DP**

Students enrolled in the Aoba IB Online Diploma Programme pilot will study over two consecutive years, divided into two academic semesters each.

Students pursue the "core" of Theory of Knowledge (TOK), Extended Essay (EE) and Creativity, Activity and Service (CAS) and six subjects, including two languages, one subject from individuals and societies, one science, one mathematics subject, and one subject from the arts or another subject from the other groups.

In addition to subject courses students will have the opportunity to participate in research projects, internships, after school programs, clubs and other activities.

Upon successful completion of the programme students will receive an accredited Aoba high school diploma making them eligible to enter top universities around the world. Students are also encouraged to sit the IB DP subject examinations in order to achieve an IB Diploma, further strengthening their academic resume while serving as a demonstration and celebration of their high school learning journey.

Live, online classes are scheduled according to a convenient and personalised class timetable which includes homeroom meetings, individualised support sessions, and virtually hosted school events.

Regular classes are held Monday through Friday between 8:40AM and 15:30PM Japan Standard Time, with optional Online After School Programs and special events held outside of core hours.






#### Year Schedule
